\*\*\*\* CIC offer **free custodianship** for students under the age of 18.

\*\* **Students Sundry Account** is used for:

- Textbook purchases
- Uniform replacement
- Residence room combination lock
- Laundry
- Taxi services
- Printing services
- Replacement of ID card
- Fob, access and mailbox keys etc.

The unused balance in the account will be fully refunded to the students.

\*\*\* **One time deposit** for damages and repairs, etc. Will refund at move out from residence.

\* **Special Care for young students** who are under the age of 16 before the start of each semester. They are placed in the YAA Program for priority access to services.

The Young ASEP Achiever (YAA) program costs \$1100 (CAD) per semester.

**Actual costs for individual student varies depending on age, duration and academic ability.**

## Refund Policy For Tuition Fee

A full tuition fee refund, less an administration fee of C\$500 will be granted if the Study Permit has been rejected by Citizenship and Immigration Canada. The Application fee, C\$300, is not refundable.


















**To obtain a refund, the student must provide:**

- The Letter of Rejection from Citizenship and Immigration Canada

**There will be no refund of the tuition fee in the following circumstances:**

- During the application of Study Permit
  - if the student chooses to withdraw for reasons other than the Study Permit has been denied by Citizenship and Immigration Canada
- After registration at the school
  - if the student is found in violation of the school's Code of Conduct, regulations or discipline policy, including our zero-tolerance drug and substance abuse policy
    - asked to withdraw from the school by the Principal
    - terminated the studies or expelled by the Principal
- Medical conditions
  - if true medical conditions was not disclosed during application process
  - if true medical conditions is discovered upon arrival
  - if CIC is unable to provide adequate medical attention and services
